Success Markers & Milestones

Success Markers: A success marker is a guidepost along a student's academic journey which highlights enrollment in a critical course, or successful completion (C or better) of a critical course. Some markers require that a student completes the course (completion) and some markers require (enrollment) in the course by the specified credit amount.
