If I want to go to graduate school, I can only do the Rehabilitation Track



Both tracks prepare students for graduate school. The Recreational Therapy (RT) track also qualifies students to sit for the CTRS exam right after graduation.

I can do the rehabilitation track and then take a gap year to work with my degree before graduate school.



The Rehabilitation Track is designed for students going directly into grad school. Students wanting to work in the field before grad school should consider the RT track.

The Rehabilitation track is shorter and requires less work.



The Rehabilitation Track allows students more room in their schedule to complete pre-requisites for graduate programs (PT, OT, etc.).

Fieldwork is only for Recreational Therapy track students.



The Rehabilitation Track does not require an internship, but students can still do fieldwork to gain experience.
