STEPS TO AN ALTERNATIVE CERTIFICATION



HOLD A MINIMUM OF A BACHELOR'S DEGREE FROM AN ACCREDITED UNIVERSITY IN A NON-TEACHER PREPARATION DEGREE.

[Example: Business, Liberal Studies, Psychology, Sociology]



OBTAIN A PASSING SCORE ON THE SUBJECT AREA EXAMINATION (SAE) IN THE SUBECT THE STUDENT WOULD LIKE TO TEACH

**If the student earned a discipline-specific degree, with a minimum 2.5 GPA [Example: Biology], then the student does not need to pass the SAE to apply for temporary certification.

**If a student graduates with a <u>GPA below a 2.5</u> from a discipline specific degree.[Example: Biology],they will need to take the SAE to apply for temporary certification.

This statement outlines the necessary requirements needed to move from Temporary Certification to Professional Certification.

Requirements may include (and are not limited to) the following:

- Passing score on Florida Teacher Certification Exams (FTCE)
- Completion of Florida approved Professional Educator Competence (PEC)
- A minimum of 15 additional semester hours in education
- A minimum of 1 year of full-time teaching experience



THE STUDENT WILL NEED TO BE COMPLETE THE REQUIREMENTS LISTED IN THE STATEMENT OF ELIGIBILITY (SEE STEP #4) WITHIN THE THREE YEARS WHILE WORKING WITH A TEMPORARY CERTIFICATION.
