

Department of Leadership and Professional Studies BS/MS Combined Degree in Recreation and Sport Management: Recreational Therapy Track

Program Description:

The BS/MS Combined Degree in Recreation and Sport Management: Recreational Therapy Track (RT 4+1) prepares students to be eligible for certification as a Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist (CTSR) and work as a recreational therapist after the bachelor's degree and also be able to complete a master's degree online in one year in continuation after the BS. Having a master's degree in the field will allow students to be more competitive for RT jobs and likely offer more potential for upward mobility at an agency to become an administrator or manager in the future. Current Pre-Recreational Therapy/Adaptive Recreation (PR/ART) students who have completed between 75-90 undergraduate credits and have a minimum GPA of 3.2 are eligible to apply to and will need to be accepted to the RT 4+1 program. Students who do not want to get their master's degree can exit the 4+1 program after year 4 and still receive a bachelor's degree AND be eligible to become a CTRS. During the BS portion of the RT 4+1, students will be able to take courses on campus or online, however, their three graduate level courses will be offered online only. During the BS portion of the RT 4+1, students will need to complete pre/co-requisites and be required to complete 57 credits total including RT/core/support courses (30), graduate courses (9), Internship I (6), and Internship II (12). During the MS portion of the RT 4+1 all required courses (21-24 credits total) will be offered only online.

Program Requirements:

Graduation Requirements for the BS:

- 1) Prerequisites and program courses during the undergraduate portion of the RT 4+1 must be passed with a minimum grade of "C" or better.
- 2) FIU cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale
- 3) University Foreign Language (FLENT/FLEX), Global Learning, and Summer Enrollment requirements must be met
- 4) All program and University requirements must be met (e.g. 120 credits total)

Graduation Requirements for the MS:

- 1) A total of 31-33 credits of graduate level courses must be completed with a "B" or better.
- 2) A GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale in all graduate courses is required for graduation from the FIU Graduate School.
