Program Description

The Bachelor of Science in Recreation & Sport Management: Pre-Recreational Therapy & Adaptive Recreation prepares individuals for positions within a healthcare environment or community recreation setting. The courses emphasize the broad spectrum of health care through treatment, education, and the provision of adapted recreational opportunities – all of which are instrumental to improving and maintaining physical, cognitive, emotional, & social functioning, preventing secondary health conditions, and enhancing overall quality of life.

Program Requirements: Prerequisites and program courses must be passed with a minimum grade of C.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM OPTIONS: Once enrolled in Pre-RT/AR track, students can stay in this track or apply to the BS/MS Combined Degree 4+1 RT track after completing 75 credits with a 3.2 GPA. In the 4+1 RT track, students will meet the requirements to sit for the exam to become a Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist (CTRS). See http://recreationaltherapy.fiu.edu/ for more details.
