OTHER REQUIREMENTS: PRACTICUM EXPERIENCES - EDH 6943

A professional degree in university administration should allow for some guided practical experience. The practicum experience allows students the opportunity to earn credit while gaining valuable hands-on experience in a variety of administrative areas. Three credit hours of practicum are required for students with less than 2 years of full-time, *or equivalent*, professional work experience in higher education. Three additional credit hours of practicum will count towards fulfilling the elective concentration requirement. Only 6 credit hours of practicum will count towards the overall degree requirements. The course is also listed above in the required courses.
