WORK SAMPLE VIDEO INSTRUCTIONS

What is a Work Sample Video and how do I complete it?

The work sample video is a non-technical presentation on a current research article of your choice.

- Select a topic relevant to I-O that you are interested in and find a recent research study that addresses that topic.*
- Prepare a presentation explaining the significance of the findings and how you would tackle them as an I-O practitioner.
- The idea is that we want you to translate the concepts and findings to a more general audience.

*NOTE: Be sure to focus on primarily workplace problems.

How to record your Work Sample Video:

You may use any electronic device that has a camera to record your video and the video should be:

- The video should be 3-5 minutes in length. (longer videos will not be considered)
- One single take with no edits with presentation slides encouraged.

How to upload your Video Introduction:

- Upload your video to YouTube.com.
- *Please be sure that your video privacy setting is unlisted.*
- Paste the video link in a Word or PDF document.
- Upload the document in the application portal as a supporting document.
