WORK SAMPLE VIDEO INSTRUCTIONS

What is a Work Sample Video and how do I complete it?

The work sample video is a non-technical presentation on a current research article of your choice.

- Select a topic relevant to I-O that you are interested in and find a recent research study that addresses that topic.
- Prepare a presentation explaining the significance of the findings and providing recommendations for I-O practices that may relate.
- The idea is that we want you to translate the concepts and findings to a more gebneral audience.

How to record your Work Sample Video:

You may use any electronic device that has a camera (such as a phone, tablet, or computer) to record your video. The video should be:

- The video should be 3-5 minutes in length.*
- One single take with no edits.

How to upload your Video Introduction:

- Upload your video to YouTube.com.
- Please be sure that your video privacy setting is <u>unlisted.</u>
- Paste the video link in a Word or PDF document.
- Upload the document in the application portal as a supporting document.
