LATINX LGBTQ PEOPLE AND THE ROLE OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT IN THEIR WELLBEING



This presentation will provide an overview about how acceptance and support for Latinx LGBTQ people looks within their own families and Latinx communities. Cultural values and beliefs such as *familismo*, gender norms (*machismo*, *caballerismo*, *marianismo*), and *convivencia*, among others, will be highlighted. Implications for strength-based approaches for working with Latinx LGBTQ people and their families will be discussed.
