- Understanding the experience of victims of abuse and examining ways to empower their recovery
- Creating prevention efforts through education at all levels of society as well as emerging legal issues related to sexual violence, human trafficking and online forms of abuse

Ideal candidates will have:

- undergraduate research experience, post-baccalaureate lab management, or have written a MS thesis and possess a strong commitment to examining issues related to trauma and sexual violence

Prospective doctoral students will receive comprehensive training in:

- Methodological rigor and experimental design
- Quantitative and qualitative methods
- Community-engaged research
- Data analysis and manuscript preparation
